

1. THE SOCIO-ECONOMIC SITUATION

- **1.1. CITY MANAGEMENT:** The law «On the strategic investment projects, strategic investors and strategic partners of St. Petersburg» is adopted.
- **1.2. EMPLOYMENT:** The level of registered unemployment in St. Petersburg is the lowest among the regions of the North-Western Federal District.
- 1.3. INCOMES AND EXPENDITURES OF POPULATION: Incomes and income differentiation decrease.
- 1.4. INDUSTRY: Stoppage of production at car-assembling plants.
- 1.5. FINANCE: City budget for 2009 is adopted.
- 1.6. MUNICIPAL SERVICES: New Metro stations opened.

2. ECONOMIC REFORM

- **2.1. PRIVATIZATION:** Committee of state property management of St. Petersburg looses authority over federal property in St. Petersburg.
- 2.2. REAL ESTATE: Yearly results for 2008 have been summarized for the city's construction industry.
- **2.3. BANKS:** OAO Банк «Санкт-Петербург» signed an agreement on cooperation with the Administration of St. Petersburg.
- **2.4. INVESTMENT PROJECTS:** «Magna International Europe AG» to start plant construction in the industrial zone «Shushary».
